
Enclosed find a copy of the May 9, 1989 letter from Forrest Coleman, three bound copies of a "Contract For Temporary Water Service", three copies of a resolution of the Board of Directors authorizing execution of the contract, with copies of the water conservation plan previously adopted by the District attached. Please sign the contracts and have Ron d'Artenay sign the contracts and resolution. Then return all the documents to us along with a check for Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) made to the Bureau of Reclamation in the envelope enclosed for your convenience.

As we discussed at the Pleasant Valley Water District Board of Director's meeting on May 9, 1989 this contract is for federal water wheeled by the state from the Delta. I presume that the wheeling arrangements are under the same terms and conditions as they were last year. At the Board of Director's meeting, Larry Johns had a copy of a letter included with the packet received by one of the Kern County Water Districts. This letter was from a California Department of Water Resources to Lawrence Hancock, Acting Director of the Mid-Pacific Region of the Bureau. The letter explained the basic terms and conditions of the state wheeling arrangement for temporary contractors. Mr. Coleman tells me that he has now received a copy of such letter to forward to Pleasant Valley Water District. His understanding is that the arrangements for state wheeling will be the same as last year. Of course, Pleasant Valley has no experience with the current state billing procedures because all the water delivered last year was wheeled under the arrangement between Westlands and the State.

Subject: Central Valley Project--Temporary Water Service (Contracts)

Enclosed as requested by your letter dated April 13, 1989, are three bound copies of "Contract for Temporary Water Service" for execution by the Board of Directors of the Pleasant Valley Water District and one unbound for your records. The contract is for a temporary supply of project water and water that has been declared to be surplus under Section 215 of the Reclamation Reform Act of 1982. The water shall be made available in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta for conveyance by the State of California to the District through the California Aqueduct.

Please return the three bound copies to this office after they have been signed by the President and Secretary of the District. Also send three copies of a Resolution by the Board of Directors authorizing those officers to take such action on behalf of the District and the \$300.00 administrative charge required by Article 5(b) of the contract.


Article 1(e) of the contract requires that an appendix be attached which will show or describe the land eligible to receive water under this contract.

Article 13 of the contract requires that the District develop a water conservation (WC) plan prior to the delivery of water. The attached forms have been prepared for use in completing WC plans by temporary contractors. Two or more goals will need to be completed. We have included a completed form which may be acceptable to your District's needs. You are still free, however, to make any changes or complete a more elaborate WC plan if you so desire. The executed WC plan should be returned to this office along with the contracts.

The second form is titled "Annual Monitoring Information" and is intended to be completed by the WC Officer from this office. We will use crop and acreage information which the District provides in accordance with Article 17 (crop census) each year. However, we will also need to know the total amount of water applied to all crops from all sources and the crop irrigation requirement for each crop. This will provide a means of evaluating water use efficiency from year to year as a part of the WC plan. If you have any questions pertaining to the WC plan, please contact Robert May, Water Conservation Officer at (209) 487-5137.

When the contract has been dated and executed by this office on behalf of the United States, a fully executed copy will be sent to you.
